From the top echelons of the classical music world, more than 600 students join 120 artist-faculty members and 75 guest artists to present more than 400 events in eight weeks. There are five orchestras, staged operas, chamber music, family events, lectures, broadcasts, multimedia events, and galas.

To support these premier events, the AMFS hires an exceptional 100 seasonal employees to join the 35 year-round staff members for an intensive summer experience. Seasonal staff work at the highest levels of production and arts administration under some of the top professionals in the field.
