Artist Biography



Recognized for intense, commanding performances, delivered with dazzling virtuosity and technical assurance, violinist **Jennifer Koh** is a forward-thinking artist dedicated to exploring an eclectic repertoire, while promoting diversity and inclusivity in classical music. She has expanded the contemporary violin repertoire through a wide range of commissioning projects, and has premiered more than 100 works.

Ms. Koh's critically acclaimed series include Alone Together, Limitless, and The New American Concerto, among many others. Her most recent project, Alone Together was developed in response to the coronavirus pandemic, bringing established composers together in support of freelancers, writing a micro-work for solo violin and recommending a fellow freelance composer for paid commission.

Limitless, initiated in 2018 at Brooklyn's National Sawdust, is a commissioning project that engages leading composer-performers, including Lisa Bielawa, Vijay Iyer, Missy Mazzoli, Qasim Naqvi, Tyshawn Sorey, Wang Lu, Nina Young, and Du Yun, to write

duo compositions that explore the artistic relationship between composer and performer. Performed by Ms. Koh and the composers themselves, these works appear on a September 2019 release by Cedille Records.

The New American Concerto, which invites a diverse collective of composers to examine socio-cultural topics relevant to American life today through the form of the violin concerto, also continues this season with new works by Tyshawn Sorey and Courtney Bryan.

Ms. Koh is active not only in the concert hall and recording studio, but also as a lecturer and teacher, and has been in residence at many universities and conservatories, including Brown, Cornell, Duke, Curtis Institute of Music, and Oberlin Conservatory and College. In 2018, she was keynote speaker on diversity and inclusion in classical music at the League of American Orchestras annual conference, and in 2020 spoke as part of the Royal College of Music's Yellow Peril in Classical Music Conference. Ms. Koh is Founder and Artistic Director of ARCO collaborative, an artist-driven nonprofit that supports artistic collaborations and commissions. Ms. Koh is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Foundation for the Advancement for the Arts, a scholarship program for high school students in the arts.
