A New Virtual Teaching Platform

AMFS alumnus, Alumni Committee member, trumpeter, and educator **Liam Day** joined the faculty of our Passes and Lessons Scholarship (PALS) program this past summer. The PALS program, which provides free and low-cost private instrument instruction to young people throughout the Roaring Fork Valley, was forced to move some of its instruction online this year. In this **blog post**, Liam describes the excitement he felt reuniting with fellow AMFS alumni and helping PALS fulfill its mission in a challenging year.

In particular, Liam discusses how he and his fellow PALS faculty used Forte, a new online platform for live instrument instruction which he helped launch. It features audio quality far superior to other video conferencing platforms, making it possible to teach essential ideas such as tone color, phrasing, intonation, vibrato, articulation, and dynamics online.
